Wastewater Labourer

Nature of the Position

The District of Sechelt is seeking an individual to join our team as our Wastewater Labourer. Life in Sechelt boasts a temperate West Coast climate, access to beautiful and varied land and marine environments, a wide range of community amenities and activities and a vibrant cultural scene. Residents enjoy outstanding “small town” quality of life with access to services both locally and via easy ferry access to BC’s Lower Mainland. This position plays a key role at the District of Sechelt. Reporting to the Wastewater Supervisor and Chief Operator, this position monitors and maintains the Dusty Road worksite pursuant to District policies and procedures, and WCB and environmental regulations to help achieve the overall vision of the organization and the community.

Essential Competencies

Applicants must have Grade 12 (or equivalent); one year proven experience in performing labourer duties; hold a valid Class 5 Driver’s License; and live within 30 minutes driving time of the Dusty Road worksite.

Applicants must have knowledge of confined space entry; WHMIS; and biohazardous substances. Applicants must have the ability to work around wastewater; provide recommendations; establish and maintain effective working relations with others; lift, carry, push and pull heavy loads; and perform other physically demanding work.

Applicants must have a professional, responsive and positive work attitude; the ability to remain calm in stressful situations; and the ability to communicate effectively and tactfully one-on-one or in a group environment.

Preferred Competencies

Applicants with valid confined space training; WHMIS training; and biohazardous substances training are preferred.

Post-secondary education in wastewater and/or BC EOCP Wastewater Operator Level I certification would be an asset and applicants with aspirations to pursue a career in wastewater at the Sechelt Water Resource Centre are preferred.

Working Conditions

This is a permanent $\frac{3}{4}$ time unionized position within the BCGEU open to both male and female applicants. Salary for this position is currently under review. Hours of work are 28 hours per week, Monday through Friday. Flexibility to respond to callouts on evenings and weekends is required.
