BYLAW NO. 371

A Bylaw to Authorize the Disposal of Municipal Park Land by Exchange

WHEREAS Section 305.2 of the Municipal Act provides for the municipality to dispose of a portion of park land in exchange for other land suitable for a park or public square;

AND WHEREAS it is the intention of the Council of the District of Sechelt that the property be disposed of in exchange for other land suitable for a park;

AND WHEREAS a Counter Petition opportunity has been provided in relation to the proposed exchange, and public notice of the Counter Petition has been given by publication once each week in two issues of a newspaper published and circulated in the District of Sechelt;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the District of Sechelt in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

1. **TITLE:**

This bylaw may be cited for all purposes as District of Sechelt “Parkland Exchange Bylaw No. 371”, 2000.

2. **AUTHORIZATION:**

2.1 The Council of the District of Sechelt is hereby authorized to dispose of a portion of that part of park land dedicated in District Lot 4679 by Plan 10981, and shown outlined in heavy black line on the survey plan prepared by Peter Gordon, B.C.L.S., on the 16th day of March, 2000.

2.2 That the portion of park land identified in heavy black line on the survey prepared by Peter Gordon, B.C.L.S., dated March 15, 2000 and measuring 25 square meters, be exchanged for the portion of Lot 13, District Lot 4679, Plan 10578, New Westminster District, Group 1, shown in heavy bold line and hatched on the survey plan prepared by Peter Gordon, B.C.L.S., dated March 16th, 2000, and measuring 25 square meters, and attached as Schedule A to this bylaw.

3. That the Mayor and Clerk be authorized to execute and deliver all documentation necessary to give effect to the provisions of this Bylaw.

READ A THIRD TIME THIS 5th DAY OF APRIL, 2000


